



Dear Parents/Carers

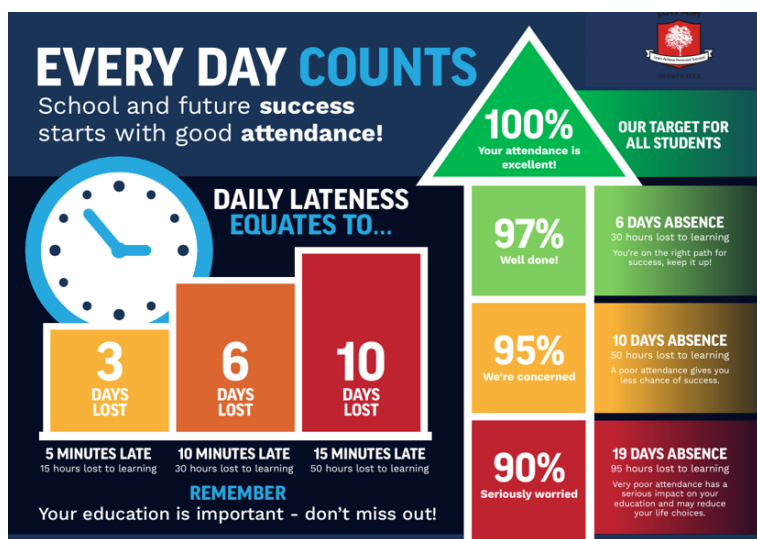
