### **GOVERNOR UPDATE:**

At our Full Governors' Board meeting this week we were delighted to hear reports from Governors who had been in school to see excellent progress in handwriting, and the Year 6 children writing beautifully, even in their SATs tests. Another Governor witnessed excellent engagement in a Year 2 playing and learning session, and we heard reports of growing enthusiasm for writing about whatever interested the children. This is brilliant because writing has been a big focus in our School Development Plan for the last few years.

The school finances are being well managed with a budget surplus from the last financial year, and one forecast for the next year. Therefore we are looking at potential investment in our facilities, and we will revisit the feasibility of fundraising for a Multi Use Games Area, which would be a significant capital project.

We are pleased to announce that Miss Potter will be set aside full time for her role as Deputy Head, SENCO and DDSL from September, which will be a huge help giving Senior Leaders more time to focus on teaching and learning and strategic planning.

We are also excited to open up some Nursery provision and wrap-around care from September.
