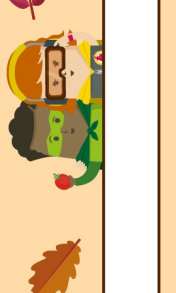
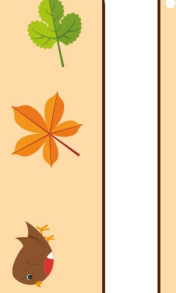
SUPPORT OVER CHRISTMAS:
