What do I need to bring?

As little as possible!

Waterproof coat

Any **prescribed** medicines – hand to Miss Potter on arrival – parents to complete a medicine form if required. We will take an emergency bottle of Calpol and gain your consent via telephone if they need some.

Toiletries and a towel– shower gel, soap, flannel, deodorant, toothpaste and toothbrush

Sun hat, suncream, sunglasses

Water bottle

Money in purse/wallet – £5 to buy lunch on final day

Teddy bear, card games/book/magazine – no electronics
