PARENT SURVEY:

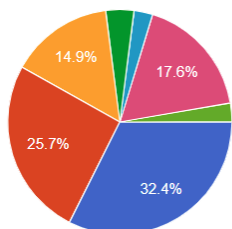
Thank you to everybody who took part in our recent parent survey. The results of the 74 responses are as follows:

Which reward system motivates your child the **most?**

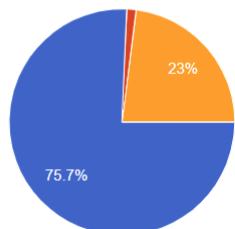

Match 3: Hustwaite 39 Easingwold 102

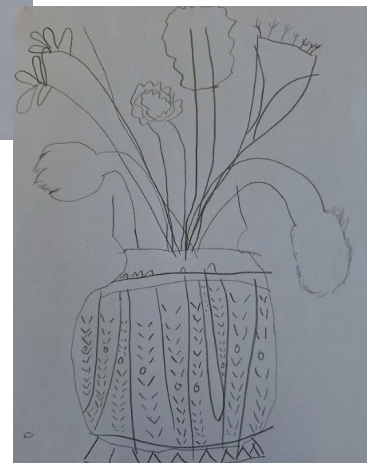
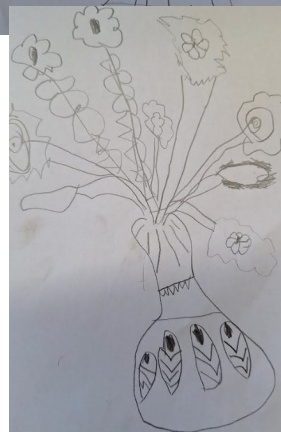
Match 4: Linton on Ouse 31 Easingwold 97


